

## **WINTER 2021 Dual Credit Online Course Offerings**

## **Supply List: Horticulture 1700 Producing Horticulture Crops**

\*Students (with the support of their school to ensure all is in place) must secure the below items ahead of the course start date. The seed packages mentioned below will be mailed out to students from Olds College.

- 6 plastic plant trays 11" by 22"
  - o sold as McKenzie Seeds Jiffy Plastic Plant Tray at Canadian Tire, \$2.69 (or similar)
- Approximately 15L of potting soil, various sizes available for purchase
- Approximately 2L of compost, any brand
- Watering can or hose-end with a breaker nozzle
  - o can evenly spread the water out over a larger area
- Any type of labeling system
  - o can be as simple as tape and marker as long as it will stick if it gets a little wet
- An open window, ideally south facing for maximum winter sun exposure
  - o a school with greenhouse space or grow-lights will get best results
- Ruler
- Scissors/Knife for harvesting
- · Weigh scale access, no decimals required
- Plastic bags, Ziploc type sandwich is best
- Ability to take photos
  - o cell phones are fine
- Access to clean water
  - o avoid most wells for rural students, potable supplies from schools should be fine
- Seed packages will be mailed from Olds College. Seeds are provided free of cost, though shipping rates apply Olds College charging \$10 per student for postage which will be added to the course tuition invoice and shipped to the school division address provided.
