## ADULT STUDENT FEES

## Background

The Division believes that adult students must pay tuition costs.

## Procedures

- 1. An adult student is a person who has attained the age of 20 years as of September 1st, according to Alberta Education funding regulations.
- 2. Adult students are welcome to register in the system, but must pay tuition fees in recognition of the fact that Alberta Education no longer funds such students.
- 3. The Associate Superintendent (Business Services) shall advise Principals, at the beginning of each semester, of the fee to be charged per credit.
- 4. The amount of the fee to be charged will be based on Alberta Education funding for regular students.
