

ADULT STUDENT FEES

Background

The Division believes that adult students must pay tuition costs.

Procedures

1. An adult student is a person who has attained the age of 20 years as of September 1st, according to Alberta Education funding regulations.
2. Adult students are welcome to register in the system, but must pay tuition fees in recognition of the fact that Alberta Education no longer funds such students.
3. The Associate Superintendent (Business Services) shall advise Principals, at the beginning of each semester, of the fee to be charged per credit.
4. The amount of the fee to be charged will be based on Alberta Education funding for regular students.
