My Professional Learning

Presentation by CRTC Commissioner, Dr, Linda Vennar (Alberta & NW Territories) - described the role of the CRTC - The CRTC is an administrative tribunal that regulates and supervises broadcasting and telecommunications in the public interest. It is dedicated to ensuring that Canadians—as citizens, creators and consumers—have access to a world-class communication system that promotes innovation and enriches their lives.

She then talked about the Basic Telecom Service Review that was undertaken by the CTRC as a result of input from the public. This review said the internet was a basic utility; that the new service levels should be speeds of 50 mbps download & 10 mbps upload for fixed broadband selection. The federal government has established a fund (\$750 million) to support projects in areas that do not meet the new service level. The focus is on underserved areas however there is not a definition of an underserved area. (http://www.ctc.gc.ca)

Alberta S.W. Regional Alliance Meeting - update on SAAEP "Powering Opportunity" and response to questions on geothermal study from Terrapin Services.

Letter to Ministers from Brian Reeves (Waterton) was discussed regarding commissioning a <u>Tourism</u> Economic <u>Impact assessment on the Castle Wilderness & Castle Provincial Park</u>. This led to discussion on the Park & on other municipal bodies in the area writing letters <u>including Alberta SW</u>. More to follow next meeting.

Proposal to be involved in the 13 Ways Partnership/Pilot Project idea to develop a technology solution that will

allow municipalities of any size - but specifically rural Municipalities - to assess the health of their community against a proven set of metrics. The community's ability to be successful will be evaluated by looking at leadership, attitudes and internal organizational performance. Further discussion to follow. Priorities for 2017-2018, 2018-2019 were presented & discussed.


