 - Chad Kuzyk, Associate Superintendent, Curriculum & Innovation presented an update on the Dual Credit programs provided with in the Livingstone Range School Division. The Dual Credit program grants students the access to programming opportunities to personalize their high school experience and build on or discover their career passions and interests. Students earn high school credits at the same time as post-secondary credits toward a post-secondary certificate, diploma, or degree.
