#### 2:20-2:35 F.3 New Funding Framework

Although school jurisdictions will not be negatively impacted this current school year, the new funding formula based on the Weighted Moving Average (WMA) calculations will result in reduced revenue for school jurisdictions in years 2 and 3 given the new funding formula. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic an increased number of parents may choose to homeschool their children this school year which will result in a reduced WMA in future years.

#### <u>Recommendation:</u>

That the Advocacy Committee of the Board of Trustees write a letter to Minister LaGrange requesting the Ministry use the 2020-21 school year as a 'hold harmless' school year thus postponing the implementation of the new funding framework weighted moving average until the 2021-22 school year so that students are not negatively impacted in the future as a result of the pandemic occurring today.
