# D.1 Purchase of the Crowsnest Pass Travel Information Center Property as an Educational/School Facility

At the April 2021 Public Board Meeting the Board of Trustees discussed and identified their interest in purchasing the Crowsnest Pass Travel Information Center property to enhance the division's current and future educational programming. As part of the Board of Trustees Key Messages this information was shared at school council meetings and posted on the division's website. Two additional communications regarding the potential acquisition and how it would be funded were released on the division's website and through the division's social media outlets. In late June AB Infrastructure officially offered the property to the Livingstone Range School Division at the appraised value of \$725,000. As part of due diligence the Board asked management to follow up with AB Education and AB Infrastructure to see if they would be in support of a nominal fee purchase of the property. Recent communication received from AB Infrastructure expressed that this option is not available and that the property must be sold at the fair market value. As AB Infrastructure is seeking a response from the Board of Trustees on the purchase of the property, Associate Superintendent, Business Services Mr. Jeff Perry will review the details of the opportunity with the Board.
