Their vision is to have "a respected and empowered school council in every Alberta school". They encourage parent engagement in education at the local (school), regional (school board) and provincial (ASCA Board of Directors) levels, primarily through the vehicle of school council.

In short, your School Council uses ASCA as their voice to engage with Alberta's Education Ministry.

Every School Council in Alberta has a membership with ASCA and can access the resources located on their website. Their site has a wealth of information; creating a School Council and/or Parent Association (and the difference between them), engaging parents and community members, how to chair Council meetings including creating agendas and minutes as well as Education Act and Curriculum resources.
