INCIDENT REPORTING



Seek or administer First Aid treatment

- First aid kits and epi-pens are located in the office area
- The AED is located near the gym
- If unconscious for any amount of time, breathing is compromised, or there is uncontrolled bleeding, keep them comfortable and call 911 for an ambulance.
 - \circ $\,$ Have the building address ready

A STUDENT is injured.... What do I do?

Student incidents need to be reported within 24 hours when students are injured on division property or under the care of division staff including field trips, extracurricular games and practices.

- 1. Notify Principal, or Assistant Principal, as soon as possible.

STAFF is injured while at work... What do they do?

If an employee seeks medical attention because of an incident that occurred on Division property or while doing Division business, the incident MUST be reported. If in doubt, report.

NOTE: If the incident results in being admitted to a hospital or death, call the Superintendent and leave the area undisturbed as the incident will need to be reported and investigated by Alberta Labor.

A SUB, CONTRACTOR, VOLUNTEER, OR MEMBER OF THE PUBLIC is injured on Division property or while doing Division business..... What do I do?

Contact a family member if possible. Report withing 24 hours of incident.

If the incident may involve a someone being admitted to a hospital:

- Leave the area undisturbed as the incident will need to be reported and investigated by Alberta Labor.
