- 1) Teton Community Group Presentation Marnie Davidson, ISS School Principal, Emilie Brien (Castle-Crowsnest Watershed), Margaret Thomas (Parents/FCSS/Crowsnest Library Board) Zander (Gr 5 student), Abi (Gr 4 student), Isabella (Gr. 5 student) presented on the CNP Learning Ecosystem: Place Based Learning In Action. The CNP Learning Ecosystem's mission: "As a vibrant learning ecosystem, we work together to facilitate learning that activates and nurtures our potential, enhances wellness, and instills a sense of belonging for the people in the Crowsnest Pass." LRSD students find that learning in different outside classroom environments can help them focus better when it is in real life and more interactive. The Board of Trustee directed the Granum Committee to meet with the communication officer at the earliest date possible to develop a communication plan around the work that has been done and is currently being done towards a Granum solution.
- **3) By-Election -** The Board of Trustees moved to call the by-election for a Ward One (1) Trustee with the Nomination Date of September 6, 2023 and an Election Date of October 4, 2023, naming Jeff Perry as the Returning Officer and naming the Substitute Returning Officer as Cecilie Fleming.
