

BOARD OF TRUSTEES KEY MESSAGES

Following are the Key Messages from the Board of Trustees Regular Meeting held on Monday, February 26, 2024. Each month the Board Key Messages are shared at School Council Meetings. See your school's website for information about upcoming meetings and agendas.

- 1) Place-Based Education Presentation Jason Clifton, Place-Based Supervisor and Griffin Contini, Place-Based Facilitator presented to the Board of Trustees regarding the progress made to achieve the Livingstone Range School Division core value of Place-Based Education. Utilization at PEAKS remains high and are on track to exceed 2500 students visits, excluding the FACES summer program. Some of the programming highlights that are offered at the PEAKS Campus include Trees and Forests, Winter Ecology Tracks Programming and Animal Corridor (Lethbridge College), Canoeing, BearSmart and Westslope Cutthroat Trout Soapstone Carving Experience. The PEAKS staff have connected with community experts and developed partnerships to help LRSD teachers plan and carry out experiential learning of curricular outcomes. PEAKS is a self-sufficient program initiative that does not take funds away from the LRSD instructional budget and is now in a position to generate additional revenue which helps support other LRSD priority areas.
